This is an appraisal based on the attending surveyor's experience, the NADA Connect On-Line Appraisal Guide, 2023 BUC Appraisal Guide and a compilation of data of like and kind boats in the marketplace and represents the surveyor's opinion and knowledge of the local marine market conditions.

EXTRAORDINARY ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1 The engine and other propulsion machinery, including gears, drives, shafts, struts, and rudders are in working order.
- 2 The sails and sailing hardware (standing and running rigging), are in good working order.
- 3 The electronic instruments are in good working order, verified
- 4 All pumps and small motors are in good working order.
- 5 Only equipment sighted, on board the vessel, will be included in the valuation of the vessel.

Therefore, the value placed on the vessel was arrived at using accepted standards in the industry.

DEFICIENCIES NOTED:

- 1. Diesel has a tendency to stall while underway, will restart after several minutes per the owner. (Note: sea trial was not part of appraisal)
- 2. Stove (alcohol type) not functional (ORIGO 4100)
- 3. Hot water system: not tested, no shore power
- 4. AC unit: not tested, no AC shore power
- 5. Electrical outlet (110V) in AC locker, lose with no cover
- 6. All seacock frozen in position
- 7. Engine indicator lights did not function on start-up
- 8. NJ state registration decal expired 2022
- 9. Extensive corrosion on aft engine mounts (P/S) and engine coupling (rigid flange type)
- 10. No shore power cord (35 amp)
- 11. Guest 20 Amp Charge Pro not tested, no shore power
- 12. No high-water bilge alarm (recommended for vessels with accommodation spaces)
- 13. No locking 'Y" valve for head discharge
- 14. Interior cabinetry/woodwork needs refinishing

It is the surveyor's experience that develops an opinion of the **OVERALL VESSEL RATING OF CONDITION.** After the inspection has been completed and the findings have been organized in a logical manner.

The grading of condition, developed by NADA & BUC RESEARCH, and accepted in the marine industry, for a vessel at the time of survey, determines the adjustment to the range of base values in the NADA & BUC USED BOAT PRICE GUIDES, and current listings for a similar or same vessel within the northeast region as a consideration to determine the MV (market value):

The following is the accepted marine grading system of condition:

"EXCELLENT (BRISTOL) CONDITION", is a vessel that is maintained in mint or bristol fashion - usually better than factory new - loaded with extras - a rarity.

"ABOVE AVERAGE CONDITION", has had above average care and is equipped with extra electrical and electronic gear.

"AVERAGE CONDITION", ready for sale requiring no additional work and normally equipped for her size.

"FAIR CONDITION", requires usual maintenance to prepare for sale.

"POOR CONDITION", substantial yard work required and devoid of extras.

"RESTORABLE CONDITION", enough of hull and engine exists to restore the boat to usable condition.

As a result of my findings and research, and considering those items noted in the "Deficiencies Noted" section and by virtue of my experience, my opinion Is that the vessel's condition is *AVERAGE*. Current listings range from \$59,000 to \$49,500 and age from 2006 to 2010. Adjusting for listings (less 6%), vessel's age (2004) and deficiencies of the vessel compared to the current listings used, a Market Value (MV) of:
